PARTY OFFICIAL DISMISSED; MINISTER REBUKED

[Text] Luanda, 15 Jul (AFP) -- Angolan President Jose Eduardo dos Santos attacked bad management and inefficiency in the nation's agriculture and industry Wednesday and said the minimum needs of the population were not being met in these sectors.

Earlier Luanda radio announced the dismissal of Manuel Pedro Pacavira, the secretary for productivity in the Central Committee of the ruling MPLA-Labor Party. He was agriculture minister from 1978 until March last year.

Mr dos Santos told the opening session of parliament that the "scant attention paid to solving agricultural problems vital to the rural population has caused an increased rural exodus and disruption in the towns. "Our institutions cannot work if those who run them do not have a minimum of the required know-how," he said. South Africa was trying to destabilize the country economically, he said, but this could not be used as an excuse for all problems.

In its resolution dismissing Mr Pacavira, the party Central Committee spoke of "serious food deficiencies" and "grave errors, including deviations from the party's farm policies and use of unsuitable methods" which had led to agricultural "stagnation."

A "public rebuke" was also given by the party Central Committee to Health Minister Mendes de Carvalho for "lack of respect for the head of state during a speech," the radio said.
